The Larkspur Town Council approved the Bear View Campground annexation at a public hearing on December 17, 2009 by a vote of seven (7) to zero (0). Approximately forty people from the surrounding Community were in attendance. Before the vote was taken several Council Members expressed their feelings and reasons for their decision which included misunderstandings about development at the site resulting in negative feedback from surrounding areas, silent majority (town residents) not heard from trusting their elected officials to make the best decision, and consideration for the future of our children thirty years from now. The exponential growth of economies (and the infrastructure that supports it) is the inevitable consequence of a system that encourages such growth...a system we all participate in and benefit from. As such, providing for future economic stability by inviting new businesses and encouraging business growth, adding new recreational opportunities and creating new venues for activities, taking control of surrounding area development to assure growth is managed, and protecting and maintaining the uniqueness of the area and its environment are all factors considered in defining the future of Larkspur.

The Town Council believes this decision is in the best interests of our constituents and the entire Larkspur community and we look forward to working with the developer, Mr. Ian W. Steyn, in implementing his vision for the campground.
