**DISCUSSION:**

Mayor West asked if there were any questions regarding the proposed 2010 Budget. Sheryl Jones asked why Town staff salary increases were included since the current financial climate does not support it. Mayor West referred to a handout from MSEC which was previously provided to the Council showing recommended ranges for employee increases and noted that Council still has the prerogative to not approve salary increases.

Eve Curry-Harbison initiated a discussion regarding recovery of fees not collected from Spruce Mountain Development (SMD) principal owner, John Arlotti, and the SMD Special District. Also discussed was cancellation of the share back agreement with SMD. Scotty Krob will research and review options for presentation to Council before the next meeting.

**COUNCIL ACTION:** Mayor West then presented Resolution 09-10 adopting a 2010 Budget for the Town of Larkspur.

**Lana Wagner made a motion to approve Resolution 09-10 adopting a budget summarizing expenditures and revenues for each fund for the Town of Larkspur for calendar year beginning 1 January 2010 and ending 31 December 2010. Kristin Cutbirth seconded the**

**motion. A roll call vote was taken. Six (6) in favor, one (1) against (Sheryl Jones); motion carried.**

**ADJOURN: A motion to adjourn the Public Hearing was made by Eve Curry-Harbison and seconded by Sheryl Jones. The hearing was adjourned by unanimous voice vote, seven (7) in favor, zero (0) against; motion carried.**

Mayor West adjourned the public hearing at 6:24 PM.
