Matt gave an update on the park enhancement meeting with Kevin Archer, an architect, who is working on a bid for the design of the park and Larry Horwitz and Bill Kramer.

Sprinkler system for the park bid from \$6000 to 29,000.

The town is waiting on the environmental study for the trail system.

Kelly and Scott Boone have volunteered to take care of the baseball field. They have the equipment for grooming it and getting it ready for the winter months.

Larry mentioned a fundraiser for the park/bricks purchased by individuals for a possible walk way or wall.

Deanna Tilley, Chamber of Commerce, listed ideas for the Christmas Tree Lighting that was discussed at their meeting: businesses decorate with same theme, poles in front of each business (8 businesses), serve hot chocolate and apple cider provided by the Chamber of Commerce committee, hay rides, marshmallow roast, donate toys to charity, donate food and can goods.

Matt suggested that community service people decorate the trees in the park for the Christmas Tree Lighting.

It was discussed that food might be provided by local businesses for the Christmas Tree Lighting. Some research on how many to be fed and what all it would take to have it catered this year.

Nancy is researching how much money is needed to provide grab bags filled with goodies for each child and candy canes for Santa to hand out to the kids.

Korrie is talking to the music Director at Larkspur Elementary about a 20 minute program.

Gary Abel is talking to Bill Fischer to make sure we can use his building for the event and what supplies will be needed (Bonnie already asked but we want to make sure what guidelines he has for the event). He is also going to talk to New Covenant about some Christmas carolers while at the tree.

Bonnie suggested that Santa come on a fire truck.

Bonnie had an idea for a "Taste of Christmas" event which is a possibility for next year.

Lighting for the park so that walking is safe to the tree was discussed and use luminaries to mark a path to the tree.

Mayor West's suggestions for a better meeting and break down of the event budget were mentioned to the Parks and Rec Board.

Korrie motioned for the meeting to adjourn and Bonnie second it 8:10 PM
