- 1. The Town Council workshop discussion on a new Water and Sewer Ordinance focused on water and sewer rate increases as well as increases to water and sewer tap fees. Also discussed were changes to bulk water rates and incremental rates for excess water use. No final decisions were made. Discussions will continue at the January 20, 2011 Council meeting.**
- 2. New flags have been ordered for the Community Park flagpole. The Colorado State flag is out of stock and will be shipped in 3 – 5 weeks.**
- 3. Material and cost estimates for the Town Information sign to be placed at Upper Lake Gulch Road and Spruce Mountain Road are still being solicited.**
- 4. Additional survey bids for Larkspur Heights roads are being sought.**
- 5. Consulting engineering estimates for the pedestrian/bike paths are being sought.**
