MEETING CALLED TO ORDER: Mayor Sherilyn West called the meeting to order at 7:00 A.M.

UNSCHEDULED PUBLIC APPEARANCES: William Lucero presented Council and Mayor with a 1954 map of Larkspur showing some of the roads in Larkspur Heights which portrayed the curve at the intersection of Colorado Avenue and Douglas Boulevard. His point was the curve has been there for over fifty years and should remain for safety reason. His intent was to persuade Council not to allow changes to the existing road structure.

NEW BUSINESS:

- **Road Maintenance** – Council briefly reaffirmed the necessity for road repairs along Spruce Mountain Road as discussed at the June 5th, 2008 Council Workshop where Bill Fischer presented a bid of \$3400 to repair the road.

A motion was made by Sheryl Jones and seconded by Steve Smith to approve the road repairs for Spruce Mountain Road proposed by Bill Fischer for an amount not to exceed \$5000. A roll call vote was taken. Five (5) in favor, zero (0) against; motion carried.

- **Monkey Face Observer** – The Mayor presented the issue regarding whether the Monkey Face Observer (MFO) would remain a Town publication or become a private publication due to the editor’s refusal to include information requested by the Council. There was no discussion regarding the issue. Kristin Cutbirth asked if she would be permitted to purchase the software and was informed by the Mayor that the software license was not transferable.

A motion was made by Sheryl Jones to end software, materials, and financial support between the Town and the Monkey Face Observer because of the Editor’s refusal to publish motions and voting records of the Council and failure to meet the approval deadline for Council Member review. Along with this, the software

purchased and licensed to the Town that is loaded on to the Editor's personal computer must be deleted in the presence of a Town employee. The motion was seconded by Joe Jeske. A roll call vote was taken. Four (4) in favor, zero (0) against; one (1) abstention, Kristin Cutbirth; motion carried.

ADJOURN:

A motion to adjourn the Special Council meeting was made by Sheryl Jones and seconded by Joe Jeske. The meeting was adjourned with unanimous voice vote at 7:27 AM by Mayor West.
