

## TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO RESOLUTION NO. 2021-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR TO ADOPT A POLICY ENFORCING APPLICABLE STATE AND LOCAL LAWS AGAINST PHYSICALLY BARRING ENTRANCE TO OR EXIT FROM A FACILITY OR LOCATION THAT IS THE SUBJECT OF SUCH NON-VIOLENT CIVIL RIGHTS DEMONSTRATION WITHIN ITS JURISDICTION

WHEREAS, Town of Larkspur, Colorado, has made application for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funds from the State of Colorado; and

**WHEREAS,** In accordance with Section 519 of Public Law 101-144 (the HUD Appropriations Act) certain statements of assurances and certifications are required.

WHEREAS, The Armstrong/Walker "Excessive Force" Amendment, (P.L. 101-144) & Section 906 of Cranston-Gonzalez Affordable Housing Act of 1990 requires that a recipient of HUD funds adopt and enforce a policy prohibiting the use of excessive force by law enforcement agencies within their jurisdiction against individuals engaged in nonviolent civil rights demonstrations; and

WHEREAS, The Armstrong/Walker "Excessive Force" Amendment, (P.L. 101-144) & Section 906 of Cranston-Gonzalez Affordable Housing Act of 1990 requires that a recipient of HUD funds adopt and enforce a policy enforcing applicable State and local laws against physically barring entrance to or exit from a facility or location that is the subject of such non-violent civil rights demonstration within its jurisdiction.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO, that pursuant to Town of Larkspur being granted CDBG funds by the State; the Mayor, Marvin Cardenas, by administrative act, does hereby adopt a statement of policy prohibiting the use of excessive force by law enforcement agencies within its jurisdiction against any individuals engaged in non-violent civil rights demonstrations and against physically barring entrance to or exit from a facility or location that is the subject of such non-violent civil rights demonstration within its jurisdiction.
