



**TOWN OF LARKSPUR  
RESOLUTION NO. 2022-18**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE GRANT APPLICATION FOR A NON-MOTORIZED TRAILS GRANT FROM THE COLORADO PARKS AND WILDLIFE (CPW), DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES TO INCREASE THE SAFETY AND USABILITY OF LARKSPURS PORTION OF THE COLORADO FRONT RANGE TRAIL**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Larkspur, Colorado (the “Town”) supports the Non-Motorized Trails grant application for Colorado Front Range Trail enhancements; and

**WHEREAS**, in the grant application the Town has requested funding from Non-Motorized Trails Grant for bridgework and safety improvements.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR:**

- Section 1: The Town Council of the Town of Larkspur strongly supports the application.
- Section 2: The Town Council of the Town of Larkspur has appropriated matching funds for the CPW Non-Motorized grant application.
- Section 3: The Town Council of the Town of Larkspur affirms that the real property identified in the application and impacted by grant funding will remain under control of the Town for at least 25 years after completion of grant funded activities.
- Section 4: If the grant is awarded, the Town Council of the Town of Larkspur strongly supports project completion per the tasks outlined in the grant application.
- Section 5: If the grant is awarded, the Town Council of the Town of Larkspur authorizes the expenditure of funds necessary to meet the terms and obligations of any Grant awarded.
- Section 6: If the grant is awarded, the sites identified in the grant application and impacted by grant funds are owned by the Town of Larkspur.
- Section 7: If the grant is awarded, the Town Council of the Town of Larkspur will continue to maintain the portions of the Colorado Front Range Trail impacted by the grant funds in a high-quality condition and will appropriate funds for maintenance in its annual budget.



Section 8: If the grant is awarded, the Larkspur Town Council hereby authorizes the Town Mayor to sign the grant agreement with Colorado Parks and Wildlife/ Colorado Department of Natural Resources.

Section 9: This resolution to be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
